

Here's your opportunity to own a unique guitar. This instrument was built on the Craftsman Experience show. You can watch the entire process on [YouTube](#). Carefully hand crafted from a kit the guitar has a Sapele body and Sitka Spruce top. It contains a number of unique features.



The headstock veneer and pick guard are made from reclaimed Ponderosa Pine, originally harvested in about 1880. With 200 growth rings in the original piece, you're looking at wood from a tree that started growing in the mid-1600's, or earlier. The pick guard is engraved with all the sponsors involved in the Craftsman Experience event. The heel cap is made from soapstone. The leather strap was hand crafted specifically for G4V. Everyone involved in the building process signed the back of the guitar.
